Reasons for Temporary Trautmann Middle School 6th Grade Campus

- Projected 2007-2008 school year enrollment for Trautmann Middle School exceeds 1,400 students; 6th grade class alone is expected to exceed 500 students
- Facility currently has 12 portable classroom units (24 portable classrooms); additional growth would require additional portable units
- Core areas of the school, such as the cafeteria, band hall and technology labs, were originally designed for a population of approximately 800 students

Reasons for Temporary Trautmann Middle School 6th Grade Campus – cont.

- Campus must currently utilize 3 lunch periods in order to accommodate the large student population
- Use of computer labs is limited due to large student population
- Space is limited and adding additional portable classrooms to accommodate student growth would be very difficult



Location of Temporary 6th Grade Campus

- Trautmann Temporary 6th Grade Campus will be located at the old Colonel Santos Benavides Elementary School located at 900 E. Del Mar Boulevard
- Facility once served as a 7th and 8th grade intermediate school
- Core facilities are adequate to accommodate projected Trautmann 6th grade enrollment

Changes Required for Temporary 6th Grade Campus

- Facilities will be renovated to accommodate the Trautmann 6th grade students for 2007-2008
- All facilities that would have been available to 6th grade students at the main campus will be available at the 6th grade campus
- Facilities for participation in the band program will be provided
- Technology and science labs will be added to the facility
- Athletic facilities will be made available
- Fully stocked library will be provided

Staffing of the Temporary 6th Grade Campus

- Temporary campus will remain a part of the main Trautmann Middle School organization;
- Mr. Rey Gonzalez will be principal responsible for the temporary campus; a current assistant principal will be assigned to the temporary campus to handle the daily operations
- A counselor will be assigned from the main campus
- An additional librarian will be hired to staff the 6th grade campus library
- An additional Registered Nurse will be hired to staff the 6th grade campus

Staffing of the Temporary 6th Grade Campus

– cont.

- Instruction remains the number one focus of the district
- To maintain the quality of instruction, 11 additional teaching positions will be added; The number of teaching positions are subject to change based on the actual enrollment of the campuses for the 2007-2008 school year
- The campus will continue to have the appropriate number of security personnel for the level of enrollment projected



Other Information

- In order to provide ample time for parents and district transportation staff to drop off students, school administration has proposed a morning bell schedule of 7:55 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. for the 6th grade campus; the main campus schedule will remain 8:10 A.M. and 8:15 A.M.
- Transportation services will be provided to 6th grade students who qualify under the state requirement, which are those students that live outside a 2 mile area; the 2 mile area will be measured from the 6th grade campus and not the main campus
