**STUDENT CONTRACT/PARENTAL CONSENT FORM**

The Pregnancy, Education, and Parenting (P.E.P.) Program provides the following services and or referrals:

- Child Care assistance
- Assistance with transportation to school and Day Care
- Summer school
- Career counseling and job readiness training
- Social, legal and health referral services
- Individual, peer and group counseling
- Prenatal and parenting classes
- Compensatory Education Home Instruction (C.E.H.I.) after delivery or when a medical complication prevents regular school attendance during pregnancy

In order to receive child care, transportation or tuition assistance, P.E.P. participants must follow these rules:

1. Maintain an overall C average (70-79)
2. Maintain regular school attendance
3. Make up assignments missed when absent
4. Maintain acceptable classroom behavior
5. Participate and be on time for classes
6. Participate and be on time for P.E.P. scheduled meetings and activities.
7. **Follow P.E.P. Guidelines received by your child**
