TO PARENTS OF STUDENTS ATTENDING UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT

Based on the 2010 LEA AYP status released August 5, 2010, United Independent School District is subject to the LEA – level School Improvement Program (SIP) requirements for Stage I in Math and Reading for the 2010-2011 school year.

You may become involved in addressing the reasons the district has been identified for district improvement by assisting in the following ways:

- Ensure your child attends school daily
- Participate in parent involvement activities  
(meet the Teacher Night, Report Card Night, PTC)
- Attend Parent – Teacher Conferences
- Ensure your child attends tutorials and enrichment activities
- Become a school volunteer
- Participate in parent involvement activities that assist you in learning how to increase your child's achievement level

The district will be implementing the following activities to address the reasons the district has been identified for district improvement:

- Turn Around Team campus visits to monitor academic progress of Special Education/LEP students

Based on the August 5, 2010 LEA AYP Status, United Independent School District met AYP for the 2009-2010 school and will continue to move forward and meet AYP for the 2010-2011 school year.
