The United Independent School District in accordance with EHDD (legal) offers high school students the opportunity to earn college credits by enrolling in high school courses, which include Advanced Placement, Texas Virtual School Network, Dual Credit and Tech Prep Articulated courses. Students should meet with their high school counselor to obtain further information about these courses.

## Advanced Placement

**Students earn college credit through the college board AP examinations which are offered in May of each year.**

House Bill 1 requires all school districts to implement a program in which students will be able to earn equivalent of 12 hours of college credits while in high school and directs institutions of higher education to assist public school in doing this if requested to do so. The four year plans for UISD high school students during 2007 and thereafter will provide the opportunity for students to earn 12 hours of dual credit courses during a student's junior and senior year. If the students meet the Institution of Higher Education (IHE) eligibility criteria (subject to change by the IHE).

## Dual Credit

**Students must meet college entrance requirements for dual credit enrollment at LCC/ TAMU which include having a 85 high school grade point average and must meet THEA eligibility criteria.**

- College Algebra or higher Math
